ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Shorelane to King County Water District No. 111.

WHEREAS, King County Water District No. 111 has found the petition for annexation of an area known as Shorelane to be sufficient and has, by resolution, concurred with the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, state law requires approval of the proposed annexation by the King County Council and the King County Boundary Review Board; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council finds said annexation is in the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county comprehensive plan, the basinwide sewer plan, and the county plan for water facilities;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 111 of the area known as Shorelane and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Shorelane to be annexed is described as follows:

That portion of Section 27, Township 22 North, Range 5 East W.M., described as follows:

Beginning at the NE corner of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of said Section 27;

Thence Westerly along the North line of said Section 27 to the centerline of 135th Ave. S.E.;

Thence Southerly along the centerline of 135th Avenue S.E. to a line 530 feet South of and parallel to the North line of said Section 27;

Thence Westerly along said line 530 feet South of and parallel to the North line of said Section 27 to the West line of said Section 27;

Thence Southerly along the West line of said Section 27 to the South line of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of said Section 27:

Thence Easterly along the South line of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of said Section 27 to the shoreline of Lake Meridian;

Thence following the shoreline of Lake Meridian in a more or less Northeasterly and Southeasterly direction to the intersection of the East line of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of said Section 27;

Thence Northerly along the East line of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of said Section 27 to the North line of said Section 27 and the Point of Beginning.
