AN ORDINANCE recognizing unanticipated revenues to Records and Elections in the amount of \$212,034; appropriating \$212,034 to Records and Elections; and amending Ordinance No. 2230, Section 17.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The amount of \$212,034 is hereby recognized as unanticipated revenue to the King County current expense fund, which will be received from city governments in King County for the conduct of special elections.

SECTION 2. The amount of \$212,034 is hereby appropriated to the Records and Elections Division from unanticipated revenue recognized in Section 1 to enable the division to conduct required special elections as provided by RCW 29.04.020 and RCW 29.13.045.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 2230, Section 17, is hereby amended to read as follows:

PROVIDED THAT:

All provisos adopted by the Council in Ordinance No. 2230, as subsequently amended, shall be fulfilled.
