

ORDINANCE NO. 2459

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Berrydale to King County Water District No. 105.

WHEREAS, King County Water District No. 105 has found the petition for an election on the annexation of an area known as Berrydale to be sufficient and has, by resolution, concurred with the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, state law requires the approval of the King County Council and the King County Boundary Review Board before the setting of a special election to submit the proposal to the qualified electors within the territory to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council finds said annexation is in the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county comprehensive plan, and is of benefit to the land included within the boundaries of the territory proposed to be annexed;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 105 of the area known as Berrydale and described in Section 2 herein is approved subject to results of a special election to be held within the boundaries of the territory proposed to be annexed.

SECTION 2. The Berrydale area to be annexed is described as follows:

The area proposed to be annexed is all in King County, Washington and is more particularly described as follows:

In Section 35 TWP 22 N. Range 5 EWM

The South 1/2 of the S 1/2 except the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 Together with that portion of the N 1/2 of the S 1/2 of said Section 35 lying Easterly of the center-line of SR 18 (Echo Lake Cut-Off) Except the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 Together with

In Section 36 TWP 22 N Range 5 EWM

The South 1/2 of the SW 1/4 Together with The W 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of said Section 36 Except for the S 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of said SE 1/4 Together with the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of said Section 36 Together with the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of said Section 36.

In Section 2 TWP 21 N Range 5 EWM

That portion of the S 3/4 lying Easterly of Water District No. 105 boundary as established by Water District No. 105 Resolution 150. Together with the N 1/2 of the N 1/2 of said Section 2 except the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 Together with

In Section 1 TWP 21 N Range 5 EWM

All of said Section except that portion of said Section annexed by Water District No. 105 Resolution No's. 44 and 42 Together with

In Section 11 TWP 21 N Range 5 EWM

The E 1/2 of said Section 11 Together with the E 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of said Section 11 Together with the E 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of said Section 11, lying Northerly of the South right of way margin of the Railroad. Together with

In Section 14 TWP 21 N Range 5 EWM

The N 1/2 of the NE 1/4 Together with

In Section 21 TWP 21 N Range 5 EWM

The E 1/2 of the said Section 12 Together with the NW 1/4 of said Section 12 Together with the N 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of said Section 12 Except the S 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of said SW 1/4 Together with

In Section 7 TWP 21 N Range 6 EWM

The W 1/2 of said Section 7 except this S 1/2 of the SW 1/4 and except the N 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 Together with

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In Section 6 TWP 21 N Range 6 EWM

The W 1/2 of the W 1/2 of said Section 6 except that portion annexed by Water District No. 105 Resolution Nos. 42 and 12 Together with the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of said Section 6 except that portion annexed by Water District No. 105 Resolution No. 12.
