

ORDINANCE NO. 2491

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to placing Referendum Measure  
2 No. 3 (1975), King County Ordinance No. 2428 re-  
3 lating to animal control, kennels, and sale of  
4 certain animals to licensed laboratories, on the  
5 ballot of the November 4, 1975, county-wide election  
6 and declaring an emergency.

7 PREAMBLE:

8 The Superintendent of Elections has examined and  
9 certified the sufficiency of the signatures in  
10 support of Referendum Measure No. 3 (1975) and on  
11 September 15, 1975, the King County Council in  
12 regular meeting unanimously accepted the  
13 Certification of Sufficiency.

14 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

15 SECTION 1. Referendum Measure No. 3 (1975) on Ordinance  
16 No. 2428 shall be placed on the ballot of the county-wide election  
17 on November 4, 1975, in the following form:

18 CAPTION: REFERENDUM MEASURE NO. 3

19 TITLE: Shall King County Ordinance No. 2428 relating  
20 to animal control, kennels, and sale of certain  
21 animals to licensed laboratories be ratified?

24 SECTION 2. The County Council finds as a fact and declares  
25 that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for  
26 the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or  
27 for the support of county government and its existing public  
28 institutions.
