

ORDINANCE NO. 2494

1
2 AN ORDINANCE relating to a proposed
3 amendment of Article 6, King County
4 Charter, submitting same to the voters
5 of the County and establishing date of
6 election and establishing a Districting
7 Committee.

8 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

9 SECTION 1. There shall be submitted to the qualified voters
10 of King County for their approval and ratification or rejection,
11 at the next general election to be held in this county, an amend-
12 ment to Article 6 of the King County Charter:

13 DELETING Section 650.30.20 through 650.30.50, and

14 ADDING new Section 650.30.20 and 650.30.30 as appear below:

15 650.30.20 DISTRICTING COMMITTEE

16 During the month of January, 1981, and by January 31st of
17 each fifth year thereafter, a five-member Districting Committee
18 shall be appointed. The County Council shall appoint four persons
19 to the committee, two from each of the two major political parties
20 the four to appoint the fifth who shall be the Chairperson. The
21 Districting Committee shall within 30 days of their appointment
22 meet and appoint a Districting Master who shall be qualified by
23 education, training and experience to draw a districting plan.
24 If the Districting Committee is unable to agree upon the appoint-
25 ment of a Districting Master within 30 days, the County Council
26 shall appoint a Districting Master by March 31st of that year.

27 650.30.30 DISTRICTING PLAN.

28 The Districting Master shall draw a Districting Plan for the
29 county which shall be submitted by May 1st of the same year to the
30 Districting Committee for adoption with or without amendment. The
31 Districting Committee shall adopt the Districting Plat within 15
32 days. Upon adoption, the Districting Plat shall be submitted to
33 the Clerk of the County Council by the Districting Committee. The
plan shall become effective upon filing.

SECTION 2. The Director of the Division of Records and Elections shall cause notice of the proposed amendment of the King County Charter to be published in accordance with the State Constitution and general law and placed upon the ballot of the county-wide election November 4, 1975.
