AN ORDINANCE authorizing condemnation of property for N.E. 140th Street (125th Pl. N.E. to 132nd Ave. N.E.) R/W 2012

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1 The King County Council on November 27, 1974, by Ordinance No. 2230, did adopt the 1975 Annual Budget for King County, and did provide therein for the Capital Budget and Program, which included a Transportation Program.
- 2 The King County Transportation Program provides for the County Road System Development and Improvement Program coordinating the kind of road with other elements of the larger transportation system, abutting land uses and business, industry, government and residential processes.
- 3 The Capital Budget and Program provides for the acquisition and construction of N.E. 140th Street (125th Pl. N.E. to 132nd Ave. N.E.).
- 4 In order to acquire the property and property rights required to lay out and construct N.E. 140th Street (125th Pl. N.E. to 132nd Ave. N.E.) it is necessary for King County to condemn certain lands and property rights and rights in property for road purposes as hereinafter more particularly set forth.
- 5 The King County Council finds that the public health, safety, necessity and convenience demand that N.E. 140th Street (125th Pl. N.E. to 132nd Ave. N.E.) be constructed within King County in accordance with the Capital Budget and Program, and that certain properties, property rights and rights in property be condemned appropriated, taken and damaged for the construction of said road, as provided in this ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County Council has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of King County that the lands hereinafter described, and other property rights and/or rights in property be condemned, appropriated, taken and damaged for the purpose of constructing N.E. 140th Street (125th Pl. N.E. to 132nd Ave. N.E.), subject to the making or paying of just compensation to the owners thereof in the manner provided by law.

Davidson 8 Tax Lot 8. - The South 30 ft. of the East ½ of the S.E. ½ of the S.W. % of the N.E. % in Sec. 21, Twp 26 N., Rge. 5 East, W.M., LESS the West 166 ft. thereof. 10 Contains 5654 square feet or 0.13 Acres more or less. 11 PARCEL 5 - R.C. Heins Tax Lot 63. - The South 30 ft. of the South 660 ft. of the 12 West 427.86 ft. of the S.E. a of the N.E. in Sec. 21, Twp. 26 N., Rge 5 East, W.M. 13 Contains 12,835 square feet or 0.29 Acres more or less. 14 SECTION 2. The King County Council determines that condemnation proceedings are hereby authorized to acquire property and property rights and/or 15 16 rights in property, together with the right to construct and maintain slopes 17 for cuts and fills on certain abutting property described herein, for the 18 purpose of the subject road improvement. 19 SECTION 3.
