

ORDINANCE NO. 2518

AN ORDINANCE relating to the appeal of taxpayers' claims for relief of taxes and assessments on real or personal property, destroyed by fire or act of God, amending Ordinance 2292 and K.C.C. 2.32.090

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 2292 and K.C.C. 2.32.090 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Decisions of the King County Assessor in taxpayer claims for relief of taxes and assessments on real or personal property destroyed by fire or act of God as provided for in Chapter ((196)) 120 Laws of ((1974)) 1975 1st Extraordinary Session, and RCW 35.21.080 and Ch. 84.70 RCW shall in the event the taxpayer wishes to appeal, be first appealed to the Board of Appeals; PROVIDED THAT the decision of the Board of Appeals may be appealed to the King County Council. The decision of the Council shall be final.
