AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation of \$325,000 to the River Improvement Fund and \$20,000 to the Department of Public Safety Current Expense Fund for flood damage and control operations, amending Ordinance 2230, Section 28 and Section 52, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The amount of \$325,000 is hereby appropriated to the River Improvement Fund and \$20,000 to the Department of Public Safety, Current Expense Fund, to provide support for flood damage within King County. \$345,000 will be allocated from the Current Expense Fund Balance with that portion which is being reimbursed from Federal Disaster Assistance Funds to be repaid with prevailing warrant interest.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 2230, Sections 28 and 52, are hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3. The King County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists, and that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety, or for the support of County Government and its existing public institutions.
