AN ORDINANCE relating to the reorganization and consolidation of King County departments; amending Ordinance 1438, Section 3, Subsection (b) and K.C.C. 2.16.050,& Ordinance 2493, Section 5.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1438, Section 3, Subsection (b) and KCC 2.16.050 are hereby amended to read as follows:

- (b) DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT. The Department of Planning and Community Development shall be responsible for the administration of the Division of Parks, Planning ((and-Land-Use-Management)), Architecture, Building and Land Development, and Youth Affairs ((7-and-Housing-and Community-Development)).
- (1) PARKS & RECREATION DIVISION. The Parks and Recreation Division shall be responsible for the administration of the county park and recreation system, including acquisition, development and maintenance of areas and facilities, planning and operation of county recreation programs, and the administration of the King County Fair.
- The Planning ((and-band-Wse-Management) Division shall be responsible for the ((planning-and-administration-of-the-county land-wse-management-program;)) preparation of all plans for the development of the county ((and-implementation-of-those-ordinances necessary-to-earry-out-the-above-plans;)) including the administration of the county's responsibilities under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974. In carrying out the above responsibilities, the Division shall advise all agencies of the county on planning, shall coordinate planning of the county with other governmental agencies and assist the Budget Division in developing capital improvement programs.

Building and Land Development Division shall be responsible for the administration of the county building, ((and)) housing, zoning and subdivision codes, including issuance of permits and enforcement, and shall administer other codes and regulations assigned to it.

- (4) ARCHITECTURE DIVISION. The Architecture Division shall be responsible for the administration of the King County Design Commission, shall administer all projects within the purview of the Design Commission, and shall administer all other projects assigned to it.
- (5) YOUTH AFFAIRS DIVISION. The Youth Affairs Division shall be responsible for the administration of the County youth programs, including administration of programs funded by federal and state agencies.

((-(6)--HOUSING-AND-COMMUNITY-DEVELOPMENT-DIVISION: The Housing-and-Community-Development-Division-shall-be-responsible for-the-planning-and-development-of-the-County's-programs-in housing-and-community-developmenty-including-the-administration of-the-County's-responsibilities-under-the-Housing-and-Community Development-Act-of-1974:))

SECTION 2. Ordinance 2493, Section 5 is hereby amended to read as follows:
