

ORDINANCE NO. 2588

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$1,019,089 of unexpended 1975 balance to the Head Start Fund for the Seattle-King County Head Start Program and adding a new section to Ordinance No. 2544, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An appropriation of \$1,019,089 of unexpended 1975 fund balance is hereby approved and adopted in the Head Start Fund as of January 1, 1976, awarded to the Seattle-King County Head Start Program.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 2544 is hereby amended to include the following new section:

SECTION 70. From the Head Start Fund there is hereby appropriated to the Seattle-King County Head Start Program:

\$1,019,089

SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
