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ORDINANCE NO. 2016

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation in the amount of \$549,270 to the Grant Fund and the Cedar Hills Construction fund for the construction of a Cedar Hills Alcoholic Rehabilitation Center sewer interceptor; revising the 1976 Capital Improvement budget and amending Ordinance No. 2544, Section 68 and Section 67, Attachment No. 1, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Funds in the amount of \$549,270 are hereby appropriated to the Grant Fund from a United States Environmental Protection Agency Grant in the amount of \$457,725 and a Washington State Department of Ecology Grant in the amount of \$91,545, County File No. 444, for centralized Grant accounting purposes.

SECTION 2. Funds in the amount of \$549,270 are hereby appropriated to the Cedar Hills Construction Fund Sewage Disposal System project No. 004064 from a United States Environmental Protection Agency Grant in the amount of \$457,725 and a Washington State Department of Ecology Grant in the amount of \$91,545 for the construction of a Cedar Hills Alcoholic Rehabilitation Center sewer interceptor; revising the protection of Health Program 1976 Capital Improvement Budget.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 2544, Section 68, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

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

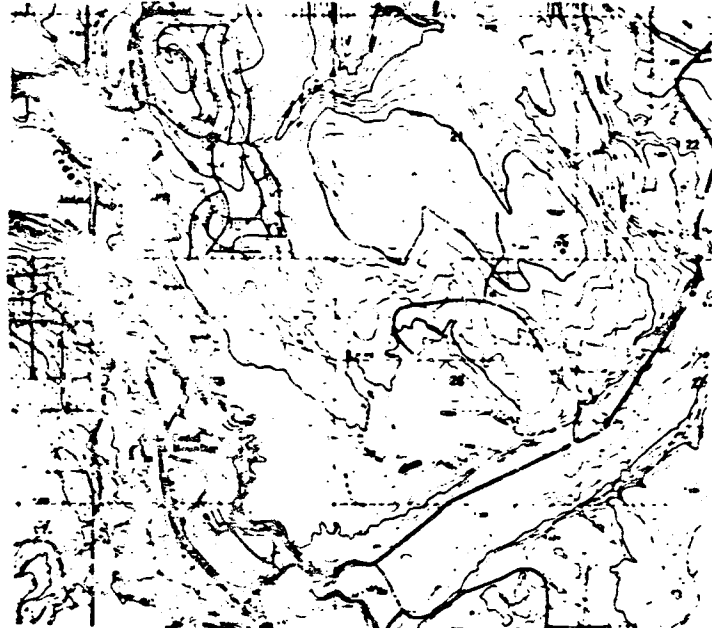
