

ORDINANCE NO. 2627

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Assembly of God to Des Moines Sewer District.

WHEREAS Des Moines Sewer District has found the petition for annexation of an area known as Assembly of God to be sufficient and has, by resolution, concurred with the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, state law requires approval of the proposed annexation by the King County Council and the King County Boundary Review Board; and

WHEREAS, The King County Council finds said annexation is in the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county comprehensive plan;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Des Moines Sewer District of the area known as Assembly of God and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Assembly of God to be annexed is described as follows:

That protion of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 9, Township 22 North, Range 4 East, W.M. described as follows:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of the said Southeast 1/4;

Thence Easterly along the North line thereof to its intersection with the East line of the West 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of the said Southeast 1/4;

Thence Southerly along said East line to its intersection with the South line of Maple Lane, according to plat thereof recorded in Vol. 73 of Plats, page 76, records of King County, Washington;

Thence Westerly along said South line and its Westerly extension to its intersection with the West line of the said Southeast 1/4;




