AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Hollywood Hills to King County Water District No. 104.

WHEREAS, King County Water District No. 104 has found the petition for annexation of an area known as Hollywood Hills to be sufficient and has, by resolution, concurred with the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, state law requires approval of the proposed annexation by the King County Council and the King County Boundary Review Board; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council finds said annexation is in the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county comprehensive plan,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 104 of the area known as Hollywood Hills and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Hollywood Hills to be annexed is described as follows:

The East half and the Southwest quarter of Section 24, Township 26 North, Range 5 East, W.M.; AND the Northeast quarter and the East half of the Northwest quarter of Section 25, Township 26 North, Range 5 East, W.M.; AND Government Lots 1, 2, 3, and 4 of Section 19, Township 26 North, Range 6 East, W.M.; AND Government Lots 1 and 2 of Section 30, Township 26 North, Range 6 East, W.M., all in King County, Washington.
