

ORDINANCE NO. 2703

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to approval of the
2 formation of Cemetery District No. 1 and
3 setting a date of election for the district
4 on Vashon-Maury Island.

4 PREAMBLE:
5 A petition requesting formation of a cemetery district
6 on Vashon-Maury Island has been found by the Elections
7 Division to be sufficient.

7 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

8 SECTION 1. The proposed formation of a cemetery district for
9 Vashon-Maury Island will be conducive to the public welfare and
10 convenience.

11 SECTION 2. The boundaries of the proposed district to be
12 known as Cemetery District No. 1 shall be all of the area of
13 Vashon-Maury Islands to be established for the purpose of
14 acquiring, owning, improving, managing and maintaining a cemetery
15 for the public safety, welfare and convenience and for otherwise
16 conducting any and all of the usual functions of a cemetery under
17 the laws of the State of Washington.

18 SECTION 3. A special election shall be held on the 13th
19 day of July, 1976, within the area heretofore
20 described, between the hours of 7:00 o'clock a.m. and
21 8:00 o'clock p.m., for the purpose of submitting to the
22 qualified electors within the described area the proposition of
23 establishing said cemetery district.

24 SECTION 4. In submitting said proposition to the voters for
25 their approval or rejection, the proposition shall be expressed
26 on the ballot in the following terms:

27 King County Cemetery District No. 1

28 _____ YES

29 King County Cemetery District No. 1

30 _____ NO

31 SECTION 5. The ballot shall specify names of candidates
32 nominated for election as the first cemetery district
33 commissioners with space to vote for same. Three qualified


1 electors are to be elected to serve as commissioners until the
2 next general election.

3 SECTION 6. Notice of election shall be published as
4 required by law.


