AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of

WHEREAS, King County Water District No. 107 has found the petition for annexation of an area known as Brewer to be sufficient and has, by resolution, concurred with the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, state law requires approval of the proposed annexation by the King County Council and the King County Boundary
Review Board; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council finds said annexation is in the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county comprehensive plan;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 107 of the area known as Brewer and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Brewer to be annexed is described as follows:

That portion of the SE 1/4 of Section 32, Township 24 North, Range 5 East, W.M. described as follows:

Beginning at the NE corner of said SE 1/4 of Section 32, T24N, R5E, W.M., thence Southerly along the East line of said subdivision to the North margin of S.L. 91st Street (Blanche Avenue), thence Westerly along said North margin to the East line of the West 320.00 feet of Lot 366 in C.D. Hillman's Lake Washington Carden of Eden No. 6 according to Plat thereof recorded in Volume 11 of Plats, Page 84, records of King County, Washington; thence Northerly along said East line to the North line of said SE 1/4 of Section 32, T24N, R5E W.M.; thence Easterly along said North line to the point of beginning. EXCEPT the North 180 feet thereof and that portion of the Rufus Buck Road (114th Ave. S.E.), lying southerly of said North 180 feet. INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 10th day of , 19 76.
