ORDINANCE NO. 2752

AN ORDINANCE referring an issue involving animal control to the voters of unincorporated King County.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

NEW SECTION. SECTION 1. The issue of whether or not King County shall enact a dog leash law in some or all of the areas of unincorporated King County by creating Dog Control Zones, under the authority of RCW 16.10, shall be submitted to the voters in the unincorporated areas within each of the identified District Court judicial districts for an advisory vote at the next primary election on September 21, 1976. The wording as it shall appear on the ballot shall be: "Should owners be required to control dogs by leash beyond their private property within areas under the jurisdiction of the _____ District Court or a designated County service district."

INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 1st day of June, 1976.
