ORDINANCE NO. 2838

76 - 692

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Head Start Policy Board to provide for parent participation and amending Ordinance 1796, Section 4, as amended.

PREAMBLE:

The City of Seattle, by its Ordinance 105674, has determined that the best interest and general welfare of the City of Seattle would be served by the addition of a parent of a child in the Head Start Project to the Head Start Policy Board. The said Ordinance 105674 does further satisfy the requirements of Section 104, Public Law 90-222, 81 Stat. 672 which provides for direct participation of parents of such children in the development, conduct, and overall program direction at the local level.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1796, Section 4, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

There is established a City-County Head Start Policy Board consisting of two persons appointed by the Seattle City Council, two persons appointed by the King County Council, two appointed by the Mayor of the City of Seattle from City departments, ((and)) two appointed by the King County Executive from County departments, and one parent of a child in Project Head Start to be elected by the Policy Council. One of the persons appointed by the County Executive shall be from the Department of ((Community and Environmental)) Planning and Community Development which department shall have the principal responsibility for the County's administrative participation. The Chairman of the Policy Board shall be selected from the members appointed by the Seattle City or King County Councils.


The Policy Board shall have authority in areas of program management, approval of delegate agency plans and budgets, and selection and supervision of Head Start central administrative staff, all in accordance with H.E.W. regulations and guidelines; provided that the annual plan and budget for the overall Head Start program and the designation of delegate agencies shall be approved by the governments of King County and the City of Seattle by

1 ordinance. The Policy Board shall report to the Seattle City and
2 King County Councils with recommendations for permanent placement
3 of the Head Start Administrative Group by December 1, 1976.


