

ORDINANCE NO. 2895

1 AN ORDINANCE adopting amendments to
 2 collective bargaining agreements negotiated
 3 by and between King County and certain labor
 4 organizations; modifying the holiday provisions;
 5 declaring an emergency.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. Approval and adoption is hereby made of the

25 SECTION 2. Effective January 1, 1978, the schedule of
 26 legal holidays recognized by King County shall be in conformance
 27 with the provisions of R.C.W. 1.16.050, as amended.

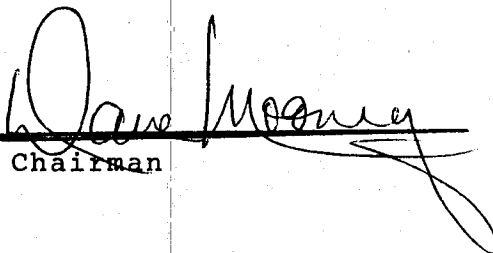
28 SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares

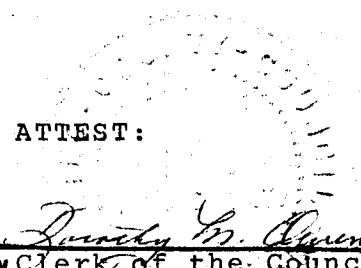

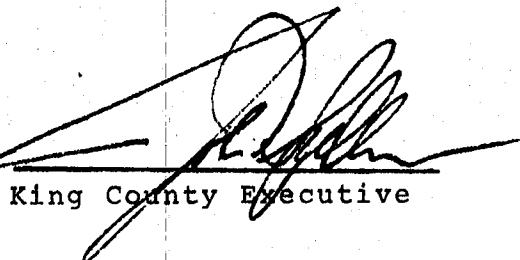
