

ORDINANCE NO. 2922

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Duvall sanitary landfill and making an appropriation of \$392,400 to the King County Solid Waste Capital Fund and amending Ordinance No. 2544, Section 68, Section 67, Attachment 1, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY OF KING:

SECTION 1. An appropriation of \$392,400 to the Solid Waste Capital Fund is hereby approved and adopted for C.I.P. project 003035 from Councilmanic bond sale proceeds to provide additional capacity at the Duvall solid waste landfill pending completion of a replacement transfer station and to provide for its closure at that time in accordance with the criteria for landfill closure as set forth in the minimum functional standards for solid waste handling of both the Washington State Department of Ecology and the Seattle-King County Department of Public Health.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 2544, Section 68, as amended, is hereby amended to read:

Solid Waste Capital Fund (~~+\$2716~~) \$395,116

SECTION 3. The project description (Attachment 1) adjusting and adding to the Department of Public Works, 1976 Solid Waste Sub-program, Capital Improvement Budget, amending Ordinance No. 2544, Section 67, Attachment No. 1, is approved and adopted.


SECTION 4. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary

3 institutions.




