2 AN ORDINANCE relating to data processing  
3 requirements of King County, authorizing  
4 and directing a joint Legislative/Executive  
5 study of present and alternative methods  
6 of providing data processing service to the  
7 County, and requiring that the study be  
8 completed by July 30, 1977.

6 PREAMBLE:

7 The County's long range policy related to its provision  
8 of data processing services requires periodic examination.  
9 Recent joint resource sharing of certain data processing  
10 equipment with Seattle, and emerging local interest in  
11 the investigation of "Facilities Management" alternatives  
12 by which private firms provide data processing services,  
13 indicate that the County should identify and analyze long  
14 range data processing alternatives from both a policy  
15 and administration perspective.

12 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

13 SECTION 1. The County Executive and County Council are to  
14 perform a joint study to evaluate the present County policies,  
15 plans and practices of meeting present and future data processing  
16 requirements, and to compare such policies, plans, costs and  
17 practices to alternatives including, but not necessarily limited  
18 to: (a) the County to continue as a provider on a wholesale basis;  
19 (b) establishment of a regional governmental service bureau to  
20 meet the needs of the County and other jurisdictions within King  
21 County, with special consideration for the needs of the City of  
22 Seattle; and (c) use of the services of a commercial firm  
23 (Facilities Management) to provide data processing services either  
24 for the County or for a regional governmental service bureau.

25 SECTION 2. The County Executive and the Chairman of the  
26 County Council will appoint the members of the joint team by  
27 November 1, 1976. The team has exclusive authority to contract  
28 for consulting services as required, as provided in the 1977 special  
29 programs budget. The total expenditures for the study, excluding  
30 salaries and related expenditures for County employees, is not to  
31 exceed \$30,000.

1            SECTION 3. The joint team is authorized to request  
2 firms which offer data processing, Facilities Management services  
3 to survey the County data processing operation in order that  
4 they can provide the team with information the team needs to  
5 assess the alternative of using the services of such firms.


6            SECTION 4. The joint study, including a written report  
7 of the team's recommendations, is to be completed by July 30,  
8 1977 and interim reports of the study's progress are to be  
9 made periodically to the County Executive, County Council and  
10 the Data Processing Policy Review Committee.
