ORDINANCE NO. 2949

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$14,000 to the Grant Fund for the joint participation of King County in the Commuter Pool Program for FY 1977.

PREAMBLE:

The Council has authorized the County Executive by Motion No. 2743 to execute an agreement with the City of Seattle to jointly participate in the FY 1977 Commuter Pool Program. The City of Seattle serves as the administrative agency for the Commuter Pool Program. The purpose of the effort is to explicitly address the needs for carpooling, vanpooling and related services in the suburban and unincorporated areas of King County. Furthermore, the County will attempt to relate these needs to the more urban needs of the Seattle metropolitan area. The effort on the part of King County will be reimbursed by Federal-Aid Urban Systems funds appropriated to the Commuter Carpool Program.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The amount of \$14,000 is hereby appropriated to the Grant Fund from the City of Seattle for King County's participation in the FY 1977 Commuter Pool Program, County File No. 675:3.


