

ORDINANCE NO. 2974

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$19,094 in additional revenue from the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services to the Mental Health/Mental Retardation fund to be used for mental health service for Indians and day treatment for seriously disturbed adolescents programs, both special projects, in accordance with Council Motion No. 2526, amending Ordinance No. 2544, section 49 as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY OF KING:

SECTION 1. Additional revenues in the amount of \$19,094, from the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services, are hereby recognized and appropriated to the Mental Health/Mental Retardation fund to be used for mental health services for Indians and day treatment for seriously disturbed adolescents programs, both special projects, in accordance with Council Motion No. 2526, amending ordinance No. 2544, section 49 as amended. Sources of revenue and amounts are as follows:
