ORDINANCE NO. 3019

AN ORDINANCE transferring an appropriation in the amount of \$380,000 from the Stadium Supplemental Construction Fund to the Stadium Development Fund, revising the 1976 Capital Improvement Budget and amending Ordinance No. 2544, Section 68, Attachment No. 1, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a transfer of an appropriation in the amount of \$380,000 from the Stadium Supplemental Construction fund to the Stadium Development fund.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 2544, Section 68, as amended is hereby amended to read as follows:

Stadium Supplemental Construction	(\$380,000)
Stadium Development	<u>\$380,000</u>

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 2544, Section 68, Attachment No. 1, as amended, is hereby revised as depicted on the attached Capital Improvement Program information sheets.

SECTION 4. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.

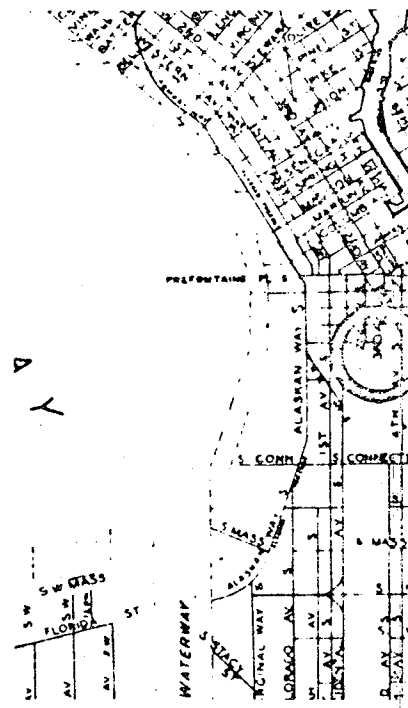

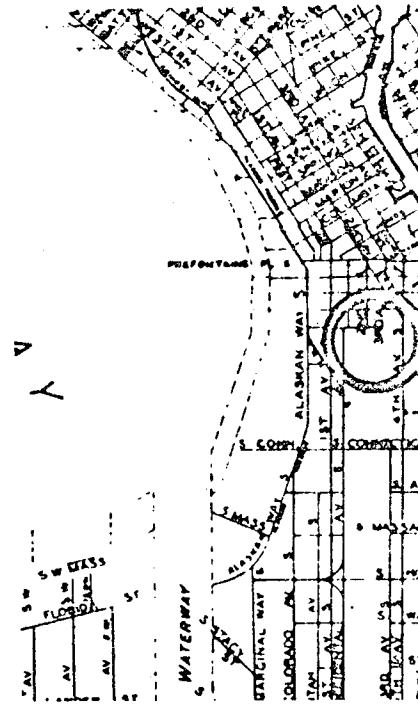
