ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$3,069,643 to the CETA Title VI Fund 00243 from new grant funds; designating the previously appropriated \$2,447,874 to the CETA Title II Fund 00216 and amending Ordinance No. 2988, Section 52, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

PREAMBLE

King County has received a total of \$3,069,643 in new grant funds from the Department of Labor through King-Snohomish Manpower Consortium for the operation of its CETA Title VI Public Service Employment Program during 1977. Ordinance 2988 previously appropriated \$2,447,874 for 1977 CETA Program operations as an allocation for the Title II CETA Program.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The amount of \$3,069,643 is hereby appropriated to the CETA Title VI Fund 00243 from the King-Snohomish Manpower Consortium for the 1977 Public Service Employment Program.

SECTION 2. The \$2,447,874 previously appropriated by Ordinance 2988 for the Public Service Employment Program is hereby designated for the Title II Program and is hereby appropriated to CETA Title II Fund 00216.

SECTION 3. The amounts appropriated for CETA Title II and Title VI shall be allocated to agencies and positions shown in the attachment to this ordinance.

SECTION 4. Ordinance No. 2988, Section 52, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:
