1 AN ORDINANCE establishing 4th Avenue SW from
2 SW 152nd Street to SW 148th Street.

3 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

4 SECTION 1: The Director of the Department of Public Works and Transporta-
5 tion has made an examination of 4th Avenue SW from SW 152nd Street to SW 148th
6 Street, along the course and description set forth below and has made a
7 favorable report upon the same, as required by R.C.W. 36.81.050.

8 SECTION 2: Said road shall be established not less than 50 feet nor more
9 than 60 feet in width, having not less than 25 feet nor more than 30 feet of
10 such width each side of the following described centerline:

11 Beginning at the intersection of SW 152nd Street and 4th Avenue SW
12 in the NE 1/4 of Section 19, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M.; thence
13 N 13°14'15" E a distance of 53.70 feet; thence on a curve to the left,
14 through a central angle of 12°00'00" and having a radius of 450 feet, an
15 arc distance of 94.25 feet; thence N 1°14'15" E a distance of 262.92 feet;
16 thence on a curve to the right, through a central angle of 15°27'54" and
17 having a radius of 455 feet, an arc distance of 122.81 feet; thence
18 N 16°42'09" E a distance of 57.06 feet; thence on a curve to the left,
19 through a central angle of 15°28'20" and having a radius of 455 ft., an arc
20 distance of 122.87 feet; thence N 1°13'49" E a distance of 491.93 feet to
21 a terminus on the centerline of SW 148th Street.

22 1305.54 feet = 0.2473 mile

23 SECTION 3: King County Council finds that the establishment of said
24 roadway, along the course and description set forth, is a public necessity.
