ORDINANCE NO. 3037

AN ORDINANCE making an additional appropriation of \$3,500 to Emergency Medical Services, Current Expense Fund, from an off-setting reduction in Special Programs, Current Expense Fund, to fund telephone transfer lines between Seattle Fire Dispatch and fire districts included in the Seattle 911 system; amending Ordinance No. 2988, Sections 24 and 41 as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An additional appropriation in the amount of \$3,500 to Emergency Medical Services, Current Expense Fund, from an off-setting reduction in Special Programs, Current Expense Fund, for the purpose of funding telephone transfer lines is hereby approved and adopted, in order to alleviate the adverse impact of Seattle 911 on fire districts located outside of the City of Seattle.

SECTION 2. Funds authorized by this Ordinance shall be provided to the fire districts impacted by Seattle 911, for the purpose of purchasing telephone transfer lines from Seattle Fire Dispatch to the fire districts affected.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 2988, Section 24, is hereby amended to read as follows:

From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to: Emergency Medical Services
