AN ORDINANCE relating to water and water system condition reports, increasing fees for same and establishing fees for analysis of water samples; amending Resolution 15311, Section 1 and K.C.C. 13.20.010; Ordinance 880, Section 1 and K.C.C. 13.20.020, and adding a new section.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

Section 1. Resolution 15311, Section 1 and K.C.C. 13.20.010 are hereby amended as follows:

Application for information. Any person, agency or company desiring a report on the condition of a water supply or sewage disposal system shall make application for such information to the department of public health on a form provided by that department.

Section 2. Ordinance 880, Section 1 and K.C.C. 13.20.020 are hereby amended as follows:

Fee for report. Application for a report on such water supply or individual sewage disposal system shall be accompanied by a fee in the amount of ((twenty)) forty dollars for each individual request; provided, however, when an application for a report is made for both the water supply and sewage system on the same premises at the same time, only one fee will be charged.

NEW SECTION. Section 3. Any public water supply purveyor as defined in W.A.C. 248-54-260 may submit water samples to the Department of Public Health for analysis. The fee for each water sample shall be six dollars.
