AN ORDINANCE relating to the 1977 King County Capital Budget and Program transferring \$206,000 from the West Central Community Allocation Project, \$108,000 from the Federal Way Community Allocation Project and \$102,400 from the Shoreline Community Allocation Project for a total of \$416,400 to the Lighting Athletic Field, Project Number 007296, and revising the 1977 Park Capital Improvement Budget; amending Ordinance No. 2988, Section 68, Attachment No. 1, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a transfer of funds in the amount of \$206,000 from the West Central Community Allocation Project, No. 007066; and a transfer of funds in the amount of \$108,000 from the Federal Way Community Allocation, Project No. 007067, and a transfer of funds in the amount of \$102,400 from the Shoreline Community Allocation, Project No. 007065, to the Lighting-Athletic Field, Project No. 007296, for the construction of athletic field lighting at White Center Park, Moshier Park, Lakota Park and Richmond Highlands Park.

SECTION 2. The project information sheets attached hereto are adopted to amend and revise the 1977 King County Capital Improvement Budget and Program, amending Ordinance No. 2988, Section 68, Attachment No. 1, as amended.

SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety, or for the support of County government and its existing public institutions.
