ORDINANCE NO. 3074

AN ORDINANCE relating to the establishment of an Agricultural Policy Committee and Agricultural District Advisory Committees, defining their composition, duties and functions and adding new sections to KCC 2.36.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. KCC 2.36 is hereby amended by adding new section:

NEW SECTION. SECTION 2. There is hereby established an Agricultural Policy Committee hereinafter referred to as the Policy Committee.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 3. The Policy Committee shall be composed of at least five members; two members of the County Council, appointed by the Council Chairman; the Council Administrator or his designee; the head of the Office of Agriculture; and the County Executive. One of the Councilmembers shall serve as Chairman. Other elected officials may be added by the Committee as appropriate to represent those other governmental agencies who may join by interlocal agreement in the County's Agricultural Program.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 4. The Policy Committee shall advise the County Executive and the Council in the implementation of the County's Agricultural Protection Programs.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 5. There are hereby established Agricultural District Advisory Committees for each Agricultural District established by Ordinance of the Council hereinafter referred to as the District Committee.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 6. The District Committee shall be composed of at least five members who shall be residents of the district. All appointments shall be made by the County Executive and confirmed by the County Council and at least three appointees shall be selected by the Executive from a list of five nominees proposed by the Councilperson (s) representing the area encompassed by the District.

1            NEW SECTION. SECTION 7. The District Committees shall be  
2 responsible for assisting the Office of Agriculture in developing  
3 the Agricultural Protection Program set forth in Ordinance  
4 No. 3064.

5            NEW SECTION. SECTION 8. The Committees shall commence  
6 its functions on February 15, 1977 or as soon thereafter as  
7 possible and this ordinance shall remain in effect until  
8 July 31, 1978. Any continuation of the Committee beyond said  
9 date shall require subsequent action by the Council.
