ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as P-245 (Tonnelli) to Cascade Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. Cascade Sewer District filed a July 12, 1976, Notice of Intention indicating a petition for annexation signed by the single owner of 4.72 acres of land to be annexed, and by Resolution 588 concurred with the proposed annexation. The District filed a June 3, 1976, Declaration of Environmental Nonsignificance in the proposed annexation. The District has a County approved comprehensive plan as required in Ordinance No. 1709, as amended.

2. The Boundary Review Board has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 36.39.170 and has found that the proposed annexation adequately meets the objectives enumerated in RCW 36.93.180.

3. The King County Council held a public hearing on the 7th day of February, 1977, has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060, and has found the proposed annexation to be adequately consistent with such criteria and to be in the public interest.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Cascade Sewer District of the area known as P-245 (Tonnelli) and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as P-245 (Tonnelli) to be annexed is described as follows:

The North quarter of the South half of the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 8, Township 22 North, Range 5 East, W.M., in King County, Washington.
