

ORDINANCE NO. 3084

AN ORDINANCE relating to fees to be charged the public for providing copies of records in the custody of King County, adding new paragraphs to K.C.C. 2.12.100 and amending Ordinance 1808.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. NEW PARAGRAPHS. Two new paragraphs are added to K.C.C. 2.12.100 to read as follows:

f) Class VI - Paper copies of microfilm records from roll film or microfiche and produced by Bell & Howell, Kodak, 3-M, or similar copy processes; for the first page of each records fifty cents; for each additional page twenty-five cents.

g) Class VII - Bulk rates for multiple copies (in excess of 10 to 25) and/or documents shall reflect actual costs and shall be coordinated with and approved by the Manager, Records & Elections.
