ORDINANCE NO. 3090

AN ORDINANCE relating to the costs and benefits of King County Road Improvement District No. 71 for road construction and adding a new section to Ordinance No. 2524.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

NEW SECTION. SECTION 1. A new section is hereby added to Ordinance No. 2524, as follows:

It is hereby found that the plan for improvement or construction in Road Improvement District No. 71 is feasible and that the benefits to be derived therefrom by the property within said district, together with the amount of any King County road fund participation, exceed the costs and expense of the formation of said district and the contemplated construction or improvement therein.
