

ORDINANCE NO. 3091

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the transfer, within Special Programs, of \$2,500 from the Executive Contingency Account to the Eastside Aviation Study Account and amending Ordinance No. 2988, Section 41, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Council hereby approves the transfer of \$2,500 from the Executive Contingency Account to the Eastside Aviation Study Account in Special Programs in the Current Expense Fund to provide the County's share of grant match.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 2988, Section 41, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Special Programs - From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Special Programs \$5,929,840

PROVIDED THAT:

- 1) The Executive Contingency of (~~(\$224,259)~~) \$221,759 shall not be expended unless the County Executive certifies in writing that funds are available and requests that the County Council adopt an additional appropriation ordinance, upon adoption of the ordinance and signing by the Executive, funds may be expended for the purposes specified.
- 2) \$38,104 of the total appropriation shall be expended only to fund enforcement order appeal hearings that are required by Ordinances 2909 and 2910.
- 3) \$25,000 of the total appropriation shall be expended only in accordance with Ordinance 2934.
- 4) \$50,000 of the total appropriation shall be expended only for purposes of follow-up investigations to the RIBCO Study on river improvement.
- 5) \$9,500 of the total appropriation shall be expended only for a minority businessman's workshop.
- 6) \$1,129,435 of the total appropriation shall be expended only to reimburse the Systems Services Fund for:
 - (a) Development of new systems approved by the Data Processing Policy Review Committee (DPPRC) \$652,488
 - (b) Subsidy for the Sea-King and Seattle Court systems \$256,337

1 (c) Consultant and software costs associated
2 with the development of the Property Based System \$188,110

3 (d) Consultant or other expenditures approved
4 by the DPPRC. \$ 32,500

5 7) \$100,000 of the total appropriation shall be expended
6 upon motion of the Council to begin the implementation
7 of the recommendations adopted by the Council on
8 agricultural lands protection.

9 8) Any runway, landing area, or other facility privately
10 owned and operated, including taxiways, aircraft
11 storage, and tie-down areas, hangars, and other
12 necessary buildings shall not be permitted within an
13 Agricultural District except when such facility is used
14 solely for the transport of agricultural products
15 produced within the District or for the personal use
16 of the property owner.
