ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE establishing an effective date for the application of County policies concerning subdivision, rezoning, municipal annexations, and sewer and water district activities to certain designated agricultural lands in King County; adding a new section to Ordinance No. 3064 and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 3064 shall be amended by adding a new section.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 2. The provisions of Section 7, Application of Policies concerning Agricultural Lands of County Significance, shall apply to subdivision, rezone, variance, or other development permit applications submitted after the effective date of Ordinance No. 3064.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of County government and its existing public institutions.

INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 23rd day of February, 1977.
