ORDINANCE NO. 3171

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as DS-22 (Bigley) to Des Moines Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. Des Moines Sewer District filed a September 29, 1976, Notice of Intention indicating a petition for annexation of approximately 1.59 acres of land was sufficient, containing signatures of 60% of the land owners, and by Resolution 1976-45 concurred with the proposed annexation. The District filed a Declaration of Environmental Nonsignificance, dated September 29, 1976, on the proposed annexation. The District has a County approved comprehensive plan as required in Ordinance No. 1709, as amended.

2. The Boundary Review Board has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 36.39.170 and has found that the proposed annexation adequately meets the objectives enumerated in RCW 36.93.180.

3. The King County Council held a public hearing on the 25th day of April, 1977, has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060 and has found the proposed annexation to be adequately consistent with such criteria and to be in the public interest.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Des Moines Sewer District of the area known as DS-22 (Bigley) and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as DS-22 (Bigley) to be annexed is described as follows:

That portion of the NW 1/4 of Section 33, Township 22 North, Range 4 East, W.M., in King County, Washington, described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the North line of the said NW 1/4 of Section 33 with the Westerly margin of State Road No. 1;

Thence Southwesterly along said Westerly margin to its intersection with the West line of the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of said Section 33;

Thence Northerly along said West line to its intersection with the North line of the said NW 1/4 of Section 33;
