ORDINANCE NO. 3192

AN ORDINANCE relating to the King County Capital Budget and Program, appropriating \$10,000 from the Southeast Central Community Allocation to the Tennis Courts Various Parks Account, for the surfacing of five (5) tennis courts at Tahoma High School and amending Ordinance No. 2988, Section 68, Attachment No. 1, Section 70, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An appropriation of \$10,000 to the Park Acquisition and Development Fund Tennis Courts Various Parks, Project No. 007291 is hereby approved and adopted from the Southeast Central Community Allocation, Project No. 007074 for sealed concrete surfacing of five (5) tennis courts at Tahoma High School accelerating the project from the 1980 Capital Improvement Program to the 1977 Capital Improvement Budget.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 2988, Section 70, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 2988, Section 68, Attachment No. 1, as amended, is hereby revised as depicted on the attached Capital Budget Resource pages.

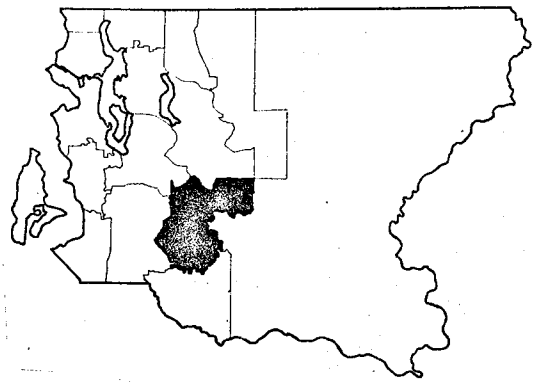
