ORDINANCE NO. 3197

AN ORDINANCE relating to the regulation of county property located in the Secoma Subdivision Nos. 1, 2 and 3; limiting uses and prescribing penalties.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Public use of the county owned property commonly known as the Indian Trail, located in the Plats of Secoma Beach Subdivision Nos. 1, 2 and 3, as recorded in Volume 15, pages 70 and 94, and Volume 16, page 25, book of plats, respectively, shall be limited to pedestrian traffic only.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate an automobile or motorcycle; ride a horse; dump refuse upon or litter Indian Trail; PROVIDED THAT, signs to evidence use restrictions shall be posted by the proper authority.

SECTION 3. Any violation of this ordinance is a misdemeanor and shall be punishable, upon conviction, by a fine not exceeding two hundred fifty dollars or by confinement in the county jail for a period not exceeding ninety days, or both.
