ORDINANCE NO. 3213

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the deletion of the area within CATV Franchise No. 614, known as Quinault Estates and assigning that portion to CATV Franchise No. 562.

PREAMBLE:

The citizens of the area known as Quinault Estates have petitioned the County of King for CATV services to be provided by Teleprompter, Inc., holder of Franchise No. 562 adjacent to Quinault Estates. The franchise for Quinault Estates is within an area held by Vista TV Cable, Inc., doing business as Cablevision, Inc., under CATV Franchise No. 614. Teleprompter, Inc., has agreed to serve the area and has applied for a transfer and Cablevision, Inc., has agreed to said transfer. The County Executive has investigated said petition and recommends deletion of said area from Franchise No. 614 and assignment to Franchise No. 562, operated by Teleprompter.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The area known as Quinault Estates, recorded in Volume 66, page 22 of Plats, in Section 7, Twp. 22 N., R 5 E.W.M., be deleted from Franchise No. 614, which is operated by Cablevision, Inc., and added to Franchise No. 562 of which is operated by Teleprompter, Inc.
