ORDINANCE NO. 3254

1 AN ORDINANCE making an \$850,000 conditional
2 appropriation as pass-through funds to the
3 Grant Fund for design and construction of
4 the Bow Lake Transfer Station, amending
5 Ordinance No. 2988, Section 51, as amended;
6 appropriating \$850,000 from the Grant Fund,
7 and appropriating \$25,000 and transferring
8 \$4,000 from the Kent-Auburn Transfer Station
9 to the Bow Lake Transfer Station; amending and
10 revising the 1977 Solid Waste Capital Improve-
11 ment Program and amending Ordinance No. 2988,
12 Section 70, Attachment No. 1, as amended.

13 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appro-
15 priation in the amount of \$850,000 to the Grant Fund from the
16 Washington State Department of Ecology, Referendum 26, Grant
17 No. 263361026 for design and construction of the Bow Lake Transfer
18 Station, Grant File No. 671/108.

19 SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 2988, Section 51, as amended, is
20 hereby amended to read as follows:

21 Grants ((~~\$12,490,290~~)) \$13,340,290

22 SECTION 3. There is hereby approved and adopted an appro-
23 priation in the amount of \$850,000 from the Grant Fund to the
24 Solid Waste Capital Fund; Bow Lake Transfer Station Project
25 No. 003061.

26 SECTION 4. The County Executive is hereby authorized to
27 expend necessary funds for construction of the Bow Lake Transfer
28 Station contingent upon the acceptance of the formal grant offer
29 referred to in Section 1 of this ordinance.

30 SECTION 5. There is hereby approved and adopted an appro-
31 priation in the amount of \$25,000 from bond sale proceeds
32 previously programmed in 1978 for the Kent-Auburn Transfer
33 Station, Project No. 003013, to the Solid Waste Capital Fund;
Bow Lake Transfer Station Project No. 003061.

SECTION 6. There is hereby approved and adopted a transfer
of appropriated funds in the amount of \$4,000 from the Kent-Auburn
Transfer Station, Project No. 003013, to the Bow Lake Transfer

1 Station Project No. 003061.

2 SECTION 7. Ordinance No. 2988, Section 70, as amended, is
3 hereby amended to read as follows:

4 Solid Waste Capital Fund ((\$694,262)) \$1,566,262

5 SECTION 8. The project information sheets, attached hereto,
6 are adopted to revise and amend the 1977 Solid Waste Capital
7 Improvement Budget and Program; amending Ordinance No. 2988,
8 Section 70, Attachment No. 1, as amended.

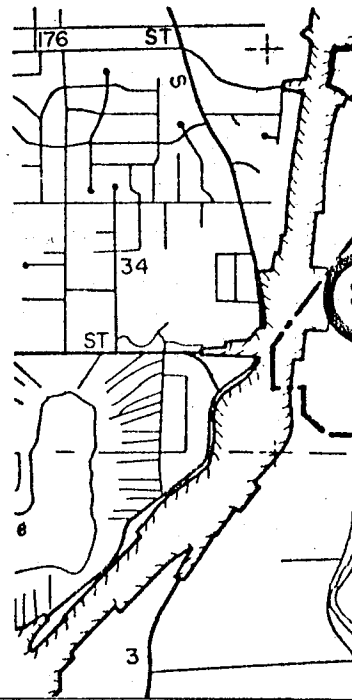

This station is the oldest in King County and does not satisfy existing standards for solid waste handling. The new transfer station will be a modern structure featuring one day's storage capacity. The budget for electronic scales, scales installation and associated site development are included in the Solid Waste Scale System Project No. 003019.
