ORDINANCE NO. 3256

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$318,880 from additional revenues from Entitlement 8 of the Federal Shared Revenue Fund and appropriating the same to the Grants Fund, in support of Council intent No. 5, Ordinance No. 2988, Section 41; and amending Ordinance No. 2988, Sections 51 and 60 as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted appropriations from additional revenues to the Federal Shared Revenue Fund, totaling \$318,880, in the form of programs contained in Section 3 to this Ordinance, in compliance with Council intent No. 5, Ordinance No. 2988, Section 41.
