

ORDINANCE NO. 3275

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$80,000 from unappropriated fund balance to the Department of Assessments; amending Ordinance No. 2988 Section 35, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An appropriation of \$80,000 from unappropriated fund balance is hereby approved and adopted to the Department of Assessments to provide notice to the citizens of the procedures and qualifications relating to HB 355, the Senior Citizen Exemption Bill.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 2988, Section 35, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Assessments \$4,816,242 \$4,896,242

SECTION 3. The County Council finds as fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and existing public institutions.
