ORDINANCE NO. 3283

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Lorre to King County Water District No. 82.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Lorre to King County Water District No. 82 was filed with the County Council effective March 10, 1977.

2. King County Water District No. 82 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolutions 307 and 309, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 82 filed a Declaration of Environmental Nonsignificance dated January 5, 1977, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 27th day of June, 1977, to consider the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 82 of the area known as Lorre and described in Section 2 herein is approved.
