ORDINANCE NO. 3284

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Anderson to King County Water District No. 105.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Anderson to King County Water District No. 105 was filed with the County Council effective January 24, 1977.

2. King County Water District No. 105 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 453, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 105 filed a Declaration of Environmental Nonsignificance dated January 3, 1977, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1977, to consider the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 105 of the area known as Anderson and described in Section 2 herein is approved.
