ORDINANCE NO. 3287

AN ORDINANCE establishing the permanent closure of Second Avenue South to all vehicular traffic.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to traffic investigations, requests of local residents, and existing traffic hazard and accident potential, the following street is hereby authorized to be closed to all vehicular traffic on a permanent basis:

SECOND AVENUE SOUTH, approximately 500 feet south of South 120th Street, just south of the address 12044 Second Avenue South.

SECTION 2. The Department of Public Works and Transportation is authorized to erect a permanent barricade and post the necessary traffic control signs and notice of closure.

SECTION 3. After the effective date of the closure, operation of a vehicle through the above-described location shall constitute a misdemeanor.
