ORDINANCE NO. 3339

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as 77-14 - Weyerhaeuser to King County Water District No. 124.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as 77-14 - Weyerhaeuser to King County Water District No. 124 was filed with the County Council effective June 29, 1977.

2. King County Water District No. 124 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 194, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 124 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated May 17, 1977, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 8th day of August, 1977, and has considered the ~~crit~~teria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 124 of the area known as 77-14 - Weyerhaeuser and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as 77-14 - Weyerhaeuser to be annexed is described as follows:

The Southwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 20, Township 21 North, Range 4 East, W.M., EXCEPT the East 100 feet of the South 400 feet thereof.
