ORDINANCE NO. **3343**

AN ORDINANCE relating to the withdrawal of an area known as Wagar from King County Water District No. 56.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the withdrawal of an area known as Wagar from King County Water District No. 56 was filed with the County Council effective July 8, 1977.

2. King County Water District No. 56 has found the petition for withdrawal to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 223, concurred with the proposed withdrawal.

3. King County Water District No. 56 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated June 13, 1977, on the proposed withdrawal.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1977, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The withdrawal by King County Water District No. 56 of the area known as Wagar and described in Section 2 herein is approved.
