ORDINANCE NO. 3346

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation in the amount of \$4,000 to Special Programs in the Current Expense Fund from unexpended Current Expense Fund balance for the purpose of funding a Multi-purpose Senior Center in the City of Issaquah; amending Ordinance No. 2988, Section 41 as amended and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation in the amount of \$4,000 to Special Programs from the Current Expense Fund balance.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 2988, Section 41 as amended is hereby amended to read as follows:

From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Special Programs (~~(\$4,346,272)~~)      \$4,350,272

Provided that:

All provisos adopted by the Council in Ordinance No. 2988 as amended shall be fulfilled.

SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
