AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$6,425 to the Grant Fund for the Fellowship Grant (UMTA), Grant File 730:3, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The amount of \$6,425 is hereby appropriated to the Grant Fund from the Urban Mass Transit Administration for the Fellowship Grant (UMTA), Grant File No. 730:3.

SECTION 2. The County Council hereby acknowledges a required in-kind match of \$2,141 by King County in support of the Fellowship Grant (UMTA).

SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
