ORDINANCE NO. 3385

AN ORDINANCE relating to Parks; specifying that youth groups and organized youth activities shall have priority in the free use of ball fields; amending Ordinance 1924, Section 4(a), and KCC 7.12.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1924, Section 4(a), and KCC 7.12.040 are hereby amended as follows:

Permits for community groups. Permits without charge may be granted by the division to community groups to meet or conduct activities in the division's buildings or (~~use of~~) on the division's other facilities; PROVIDED THAT, (~~during the months of April, May and June of each year youth groups and organized youth activities for youth eighteen years of age or under shall have priority in the use of ball field facilities; PROVIDED FURTHER THAT,~~) no charges shall be levied for use of ball fields for athletic activities involving play by those exclusively eighteen years of age or under; PROVIDED FURTHER THAT, the buildings or facilities are not otherwise required by the division and the activities are:

- (1) Conducted in accordance with the division's standards.
- (2) Held without admission charge;
- (3) Not conducted for private voluntary gain;
- (4) Open to the general public without discrimination;
- (5) Scheduled during hours when the building is regularly

open.

Applications for facilities cannot be reserved for more than thirty days in advance. A limited number of revocable permits will be issued to groups desiring the use of the facilities regularly on dates scheduled over the thirty day limit.
