ORDINANCE NO. 3461

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$32,000 to the Department of Public Safety for the purpose of hiring and training twenty-one new commissioned personnel; amending Ordinance 2988, Section 26, as amended; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An appropriation of \$32,000 to the Department of Public Safety is hereby approved and adopted from unappropriated Current Expense Fund balance. The purpose of this appropriation is to allow King County to hire and train twenty-one new police officers.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 2988, Section 26, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 26. Public Safety - From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Public Safety                    ({\$12,373,968})            \$12,405,968

PROVIDED THAT:

- 1) The provisos adopted by the Council in Ordinance 2988, as subsequently amended, shall be fulfilled.

SECTION 3. The Council Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of County government and its existing public institutions.
